REMEMBER:

- 1) Prerequisites must have been completed with a grade of C or better **BEFORE** taking the course.
- 2) Courses completed with a D or P do not count.
- 3) Courses may not be taken concurrently with the course for which they are a prerequisite (e.g., ECON 360 and ECON 440).
