## **SCHOOL OF MANAGEMENT COURSES** **APPROVED AS ELECTIVES FOR THE** **MA IN ECONOMICS**

All 500-level FIN course are acceptable.

Please note that all of these courses require a background in introductory accounting and finance courses, or a prerequisite of MGMT 501, Accounting for Managers, and MGMT 505, Finance for Managers.

*Students are assumed to have had previous exposure at the undergraduate level to financial accounting. If not, MGMT 501 - Accounting for Managers (or an undergraduate course in financial accounting such as ACCT 211), must be taken first, but will **not** be counted toward the MA. Students with no previous exposure to finance must also take MGMT 505 as one of the courses counted towards degree requirements.*

For students pursuing the MA in Economics and Finance, the following courses are especially recommended:
